
AT A GLANCE: THE STATE OF PUBLIC ART



The city of Columbus and Franklin County have partnered with the Greater Columbus Arts Council and Lord Cultural Resources to create a plan for the future of public art in Greater Columbus. Over the past eight months, the planning process has been led by a steering group that includes artists, organizers, and other local leaders.

Key insights

- Significant portions of Greater Columbus are devoid of any documented public artworks.
- Residents want to see public art fully represent the diversity of Greater Columbus.
- Artists, business owners, city staff and funders are confused or delayed by the process of creating public art. Community art projects need a separate expedited review process.
- There is a strong desire for a "new Columbus Way" that establishes a consistent public funding **source** for public art (like a percent for art) and encourages participation by private donors.
